Disasters Emergency
Committee Appeal for
Rohingya refugees.

More than 500,000 Rohingya refugees have crossed the border into Bangladesh and many more are displaced in Myanmar. As villages in Myanmar continue to be destroyed, figures are expected to rise, with up to 15,000 people crossing the border each day. Bangladesh is itself one of the world's poorest countries, already struggling to cope with millions of their own population affected by some of the worst flooding in decades. The DEC have launched an appeal to help provide emergency relief in this crisis. There will be an opportunity for you to give to this appeal using the Emergency Appeal envelopes available in Church this morning.
